☛ Submission of Manuscript

The language of the journal is English. Papers should deal with original research not previously published or being considered for publication elsewhere. The submitted paper should be accompanied with names, emails, telephone and fax numbers, and addresses of the author. Manuscripts should be submitted in one hardcopy along with a soft copy by Email. The text should be typed using Word (**front size 12 points Times New Romans**) including tables and captions. The illustration should be in separate sheets. It is important that the file and the print be identical. The files can be sent as attachments to email and/or be submitted on a CD to the editorial office.

☛ Types of Articles

Article will be published in the following categories:

☛ Research Papers:

A full paper must be subdivided into sections e.g. Introduction, Experimental Procedure, Results, Discussion and Conclusion. The research papers should write minimum 3000 and maximum 4000 words. Abstracts and conclusions are compulsory.

☛ Manuscript Preparation:

Title page: In addition to a brief, descriptive, concise title of the Article (capital letters); the full name of the author(s), academic or professional affiliation and addresses should be included on the title page. The name and complete addresses including Telephone number, Fax number and E-mail address of the person to whom all correspondence to be send must be given on the title page. This page should not be numbered.

☛ **Formats:** Manuscript should be computer typed in double spacing on one side of A4 size white paper, leaving 1 inch in every side.

Main Text

☛ **Headings:** The manuscript should be divided into Introduction, Experimental procedure, Results, Discussion, Conclusion and references. The introduction and conclusions are compulsory.

☛ **Abstract and Keywords:** Abstract is a concise summary of the whole paper and should briefly state the objective and approach and give the summary of results and conclusions drawn in one paragraph (**200 words**). Its use is to provide a quick outline of your presentation, giving the reader an overview of the research. This is an important aspect of your paper, as it is the description that may attract the reader to continue and finish your full report. In particular, the main contributions of the paper should be explicitly mentioned in the abstract. No citations or cross-references should be used there. Keywords should be so chosen that they best describe the contents of the paper.

☛ **Tables:** Tables should be typed single-spaced

☛ **References:** In case of book, reference should include the author's name; title; place of publication; publisher; year of publication; page numbers. If the author collects data from website then the author should mention about the websites.
